JUDGES' TIPS

- Remember to illustrate how and why we should protect ourselves from the sun.
- Think outside the umbrella! Protecting yourself from sun damage at the beach is important, but we need to be sun safe in lots of places. Where else do people need sunscreen, a hat, sunglasses and a long sleeved shirt?
- Each poster will be judged on its artistic merit, creativity, originality, and its accurate, effective message.
- Make sure all text is clear and legible from a distance.
- The winning posters may be seen on TV. Use bright, bold colors, and fill the entire page.
- Posters can be created in any medium, and either hand-drawn or computer generated. Please spray-fix dry media like pastels and pencil. You can purchase spray fixative at any art or craft supply store.
- Make sure that any collage elements are firmly affixed to your poster.
- Fill out the entry form legibly, cut it along the dotted line, and glue or tape it securely to the back of your poster. Do not use staples or paper clips.
- Send entries so that they arrive no later than April 11, 2011. Late entries will be disqualified.
- All entries become the property of the Maryland Skin Cancer Prevention Program and are not returned.
