



Breast and Cervical Cancer Screening Program Baltimore City: 410.350.2001

Free Mammogram, Pap Test, & Breast Exam

Eligibility: To be eligible to receive services under this program, a woman must meet the following criteria:

- **Residency:** A woman must be a Maryland resident.
- **Age:** Women must be 40-64 years of age. Women over 65 without Medicare, or with Medicare **Part A only** are eligible for this program.
- **Insurance:** Women eligible for this program must either be uninsured or have health insurance which does not cover the screening procedures. Women on Medical Assistance, and women enrolled in Medicare Part B, HMOs or PPOs are **NOT** eligible for this program.
- **Income:** Women with household incomes at or below 250% of the federal poverty level are eligible for this program. For example, in 2008, a single person with a household income of \$26,000 or less would be eligible; a family of two with a household income of \$35,000 or less is eligible. Add \$9000 for each additional family member.
